The Organizing Committee of the 38th IEEE International Conference on Microelectronics (ICM 2026) invites **Cross-Society Special Session Proposals** for the conference, to be held in the Borneo Cultures Museum, Kuching, Sarawak, Malaysia, from December 7th to 10th, 2026.

These sessions are designed to complement the regular technical program by showcasing emerging research areas, transformative ideas, and innovative applications that span across traditional disciplinary boundaries.

Proposals should focus on timely, high-impact topics that are likely to stimulate cross-disciplinary collaboration and attract broad interest. All papers submitted to Cross-Society Special Sessions will undergo the same rigorous peer-review process as regular submissions to ensure the highest quality standards.

Proposal Requirements (3 pages max.):

Proposals should include the following information:

- 1. Joint Organization:** Each Cross-Society Special Session must be jointly organized by members from at least two different IEEE societies.
- 2. Title and abstract:** A title and a concise abstract.
- 3. Rationale:** Explain why the topic is emerging and timely, describe its relevance to the ICM 2026 community and alignment with the innovation themes (if applicable).
- 4. Proposed speakers:** Provide a list of all talks, speakers, and co-authors (in each associated paper). Cross-society special sessions are normally expected to have 5 papers.
- 5. Short biographies:** Provide a short bio-sketch of the session proposers.
