INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON MICROELECTRONICS

The Organizing Committee of the 38th IEEE International Conference on Microelectronics (ICM 2026) invites **Special Session Proposals** for the conference, to be held in the Borneo Cultures Museum, Kuching, Sarawak, Malaysia, from December 7th to 10th, 2026.

Special Sessions aim to complement the regular technical program by highlighting emerging research areas, innovative applications, interdisciplinary topics, and recent advances in microelectronics, circuits, and systems. Proposals should address timely, compelling, and high-impact areas of research, especially those that strengthen academic-industrial collaboration and regional/global cooperation within the microelectronics community.

Special Sessions Proposal Submission Guidelines (maximum 3 pages):

Proposal should include the following information:

- Title & Abstract:** A title and concise abstract clearly describing the session's topic, scope, and expected impact.
- Rationale:** Explain why the topic is novel and timely, its relevance to the ICM community, and its expected contribution to the conference program.
- Proposed Speakers:** Provide a list of proposed papers, including titles, authors, and affiliations. A standard special session is expected to include 5 papers. In exceptional cases (e.g., invited industrial speakers or extended presentations), you may propose a session with fewer papers or double time-slot. Please consult with Special Session co-chairs in advance to explain the rationale of your request if this applies.
- Biographical Sketches:** Provide brief biographical sketches of the session organizers. The involvement of industry speakers is strongly encouraged.

Strict no-show policy: Any accepted special session paper must be presented as such at the conference. No-shows will not result in an IEEE Xplore publication.
